- If a recruiter asks you to e-mail your resume to his/her company, don't feel you are being brushed off. Companies require their recruiters to direct job seekers to their sites to obtain HR information as required by law and to direct desirable job seekers to different departments—a good reason for you to network for unlisted open jobs!
- Don't stand in a long line for one of your "A list" companies if the recruiters at a "B list" booth don't look busy—even if the event is in its last hour. Take advantage of the opportunity to tell your complete story to the "B" recruiters.
