- full time student in the UIC College of Business Administration
- Actg students are encouraged to apply
- not graduating before May 2003
- 3.5 UIC and cumulative gpa

Michael N. Bitsas Memorial Scholarship - \$500

- full time student in the UIC College of Business Administration
- not graduating before May 2003
- majoring in Mgmt or Mktg, preference given to students concentrating in International Business
- 3.5 UIC and cumulative gpa

Distinguished Alumni Scholarship - \$500

- full time student in the UIC College of Business Administration
- active participant in CBA student organizations
- senior standing not graduating before May 2003
- 4.00 UIC and cumulative gpa

Polk Brothers Scholarship – Ten awards at \$1,000 each

- full time student in the UIC College of Business Administration
- freshman, sophomore, junior or senior standing not graduating before May 2003
- demonstrate financial need
- 3.5 UIC and cumulative gpa

Viola Lance Scholarship (female) - \$1,000

Marilyn Fors Scholarship (female) - \$500

Gerald Lance Scholarship (male) - \$1,000

Eric Werner Fors Scholarship (male) - \$500

- full time student in the UIC College of Business Administration
- citizen of the United States and a resident of the state of Illinois
- junior or senior standing not graduating before May 2003
- Actg students are not eligible for these awards
- 3.75 UIC and cumulative gpa

The purpose of these award is to provide a scholarship to a full-time student entering his/her junior or senior year, enrolled in the CBA, where the declared major field of study is a business discipline, except accounting. - must be an African-American, Latino(a), or Native American student

- full time student in the UIC College of Business Administration for the entire 2002-2003 academic year
- must commit to tutoring elementary-school students 4 hours per week
- completion of 15 semester hours at UIC and 3.5 cumulative gpa
