The NSBE-UIC Point System

The purpose of creating a new point system is so that the NSBE members with the highest point totals will make it easier to select who will receive NSBE scholarships, as an aid in choosing attendance for the Region IV Fall Conference in Detroit, MI (Nov. 21-23, 2008) and National Convention in Las Vegas, NV (March 25 - 29, 2008; during Spring Break, among other things. **The point totals will be summed for the Fall Regional Conference at our meeting on October 13, 2008. The point totals will be summed for the National Convention at our meeting on January 19, 2009.** These dates have been chosen so that we can plan earlier for the trips, make transportation arrangements, etc.

The point system will be refreshed after the summing of points for the Fall conference. There will be separate opportunities for members who join NSBE later during the Fall 2008 and Spring 2009 semesters to attend the conferences.

Point System Setup:

Attending General Meetings (**5 points each**)

“NSBE Weekly Challenge Questions” will be given at NSBE general meetings for points (5 Questions, **5 points max** per meeting).

Giveaways will also be given away from time to time also.

Members will receive **5 points** for voting in the General Election and showing their election receipts.

Volunteering to help the Chapter (when asked, or in special cases such as helping E-board members with small tasks on their committees) (**10 points max, depending on the weight of the task**)

Attending extracurricular NSBE-sponsored events (not including Fall Regional Conference, and Nationals) (**5 points**) - Include those who signed up for the Museum trip

Being prepared for special NSBE events (e.g. Resume Workshop) (plus 2 points)

Any changes to this point system will be announced later (by email, meetings, and website)
