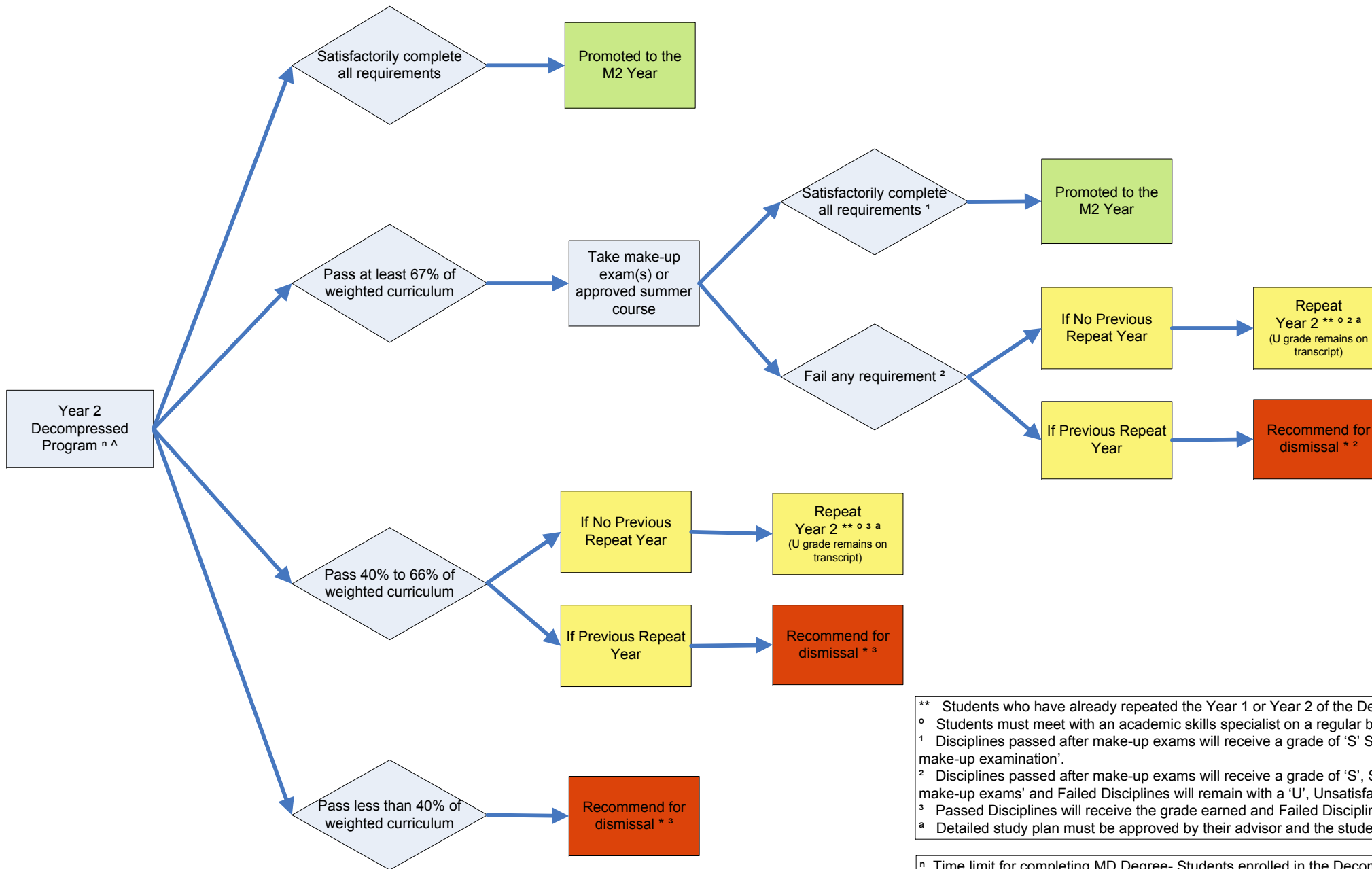


Chicago Decompressed Program Year 2 Promotion Policy



\*\* Students who have already repeated the Year 1 or Year 2 of the Decompressed Program are subject to dismissal.  
 o Students must meet with an academic skills specialist on a regular basis.  
 1 Disciplines passed after make-up exams will receive a grade of 'S' Satisfactory with a comment notating 'Passed after make-up examination'.  
 2 Disciplines passed after make-up exams will receive a grade of 'S', Satisfactory, with a comment notation "Passed after make-up exams' and Failed Disciplines will remain with a 'U', Unsatisfactory, grade.  
 3 Passed Disciplines will receive the grade earned and Failed Disciplines will remain with a 'U', Unsatisfactory, grade.  
 a Detailed study plan must be approved by their advisor and the student affairs dean.

n Time limit for completing MD Degree- Students enrolled in the Decompressed Program must complete their medical curriculum within 8 years from the date of initial enrollment. A maximum of 5 years to complete the M1 & M2 years, including passing USMLE Step 1.  
 ^ Students returning from LOA, in a Restart Year or Continuing will have their Academic Record reviewed by the Assoc. Dean for Curriculum, Assoc. Dean for Students and the COM Registrar's Office to determine curriculum requirements.
